K-1st Review Questions

1. What prophet did we read about in today's lesson? *Jeremiah.*
2. What special job did God give to Jeremiah? *To be a prophet.*
3. When did God choose Jeremiah for this special job: before he was born, when he was a boy, or when he grew up? *Before he was born.*
4. What was Jeremiah afraid he might not be able to do well enough: speak, hear, or see? *Speak.*
5. Why did God say Jeremiah should not be afraid? Who would be with Jeremiah? *God would be with him.*
6. How would Jeremiah know what to say? *God would give him the words to say.*
7. Whose house did God tell Jeremiah to visit? *The potter's house.*
8. What did Jeremiah see when he went to the potter's house? What was wrong with the clay object the potter was making on the wheel? *It was spoiled/messed up.*
9. What did the potter do with the spoiled clay: threw it away, put it on the shelf, or remade it into something else? *Remade it into something else.*
10. At the potter's house, God was giving the people a picture: God was like the potter and who was like the clay? *The people of Judah.*
11. Just as the potter's first clay was spoiled, or ruined, how were the people spoiled? *By sin.*
12. Like the potter with the ruined clay, what would God do to Judah if they did not turn from their sin: nothing, throw them out, or smash and remake them? *Smash and remake them.*
13. After the people heard Jeremiah's message, did they follow God's plan or their own evil plans? *Their own evil plans.*
14. How did Pashhur punish Jeremiah for speaking in the temple? *He beat him and put him in the stocks.*
15. What did God want the people of Judah to do? *Turn from their sin and turn back to God.*
16. Jeremiah is called "the weeping prophet." What does weeping mean? *Crying.*
17. What is one reason Jeremiah wept or cried? *Because the people wouldn't turn back to God; he knew God*

would send a disaster; the people punished him instead of listening to him.

18. Who can say the memory verse? *Allow students to recite the verse.*
