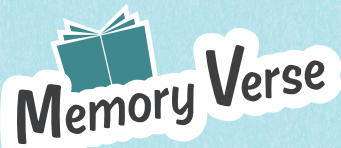

What if you heard a friend say that the Bible's account of Jericho is just a story—a fairy tale. **What could you say?**

We can trust the Bible's historical accounts to be true. The Bible is God's Word, and God can't lie. There have also been many archaeological digs in the area of Jericho. In fact, archaeologists found the city! Their findings confirmed all the details in the biblical account of Jericho. The city's walls fell just like the Bible says. And the ash and debris found there also fit with the Israelites' destruction of the city by fire. These findings—and more—confirm what we know from the Bible to be true about Jericho.
