# **Review Questions**

### Lesson 111

- 1. Which prophet used a rainbow to describe his vision of God's glory? *Ezekiel*.
- 2. What did Isaiah say when he was overwhelmed by his sin in the presence of the holy God: "Great is the Lord," "I'm done for," or "Woe is me"? "Woe is me."
- In Isaiah's vision, what creatures did he see worshipping God: cherubim, seraphim, or eagles? Seraphim.
- 4. Who did the Apostle John see in his vision of heaven? Jesus, the Son of Man.

# Lesson 112

- 5. To which prophet did God give the message about the new covenant: Isaiah, Jeremiah, or Malachi? *Jeremiah*.
- 6. What did the priests have to offer over and over to cover people's sins in the old covenant? *Animal sacrifices*.
- 7. Under the old covenant, what was impossible for the people to obey? The laws of God, the Ten Commandments.
- 8. Instead of many animal sacrifices, what kind of sacrifice did God promise in the new covenant? One perfect sacrifice—Jesus Christ.
- 9. Salvation is a free *what* through Jesus' death on the cross? *Gift*.

# Lesson 113

- 10. Which Persian king allowed the first group of Jews to return to Judah: Ahasuerus, Artaxerxes, or Cyrus? *Cyrus*.
- 11. Who led the first group of Jews back to Jerusalem: Zerubbabel, King Artaxerxes, or Daniel? Zerubbabel.
- 12. What did Zerubbabel and the Jews rebuild in Jerusalem: the palace, the temple, or the city walls? *The temple*.

- 13. How long did it take the Jews to finish the temple because of their enemies: 10 years, 21 years, or 41 years? 21 years.
- 14. What promise of God was fulfilled when King Cyrus said the Jews could return to Jerusalem? That they would return home after 70 years of captivity.

## Lesson 114

- 15. Who did God choose to become queen of Persia? *Esther*.
- 16. Who was Esther's cousin? Mordecai.
- **17.** Why did Haman get angry with Mordecai? *Because Mordecai refused to bow to him.*
- 18. What did the king do when Esther came to him without being invited? He held out his scepter to her.
- 19. The king allowed Mordecai to write a new law that would let the Jews do what? Protect themselves from their enemies.

#### Lesson 115

- 20. Which priest, who was also a scribe, led the second group of Jews back to Judah? *Ezra*.
- **21.** What did Ezra want to teach the people? *The Law of the Lord; Law of Moses; God's Word.*
- 22. When Ezra got to Jerusalem, how were the Jews disobeying God? They were marrying foreign (non-Jewish) people who led them to worship their false gods.
- 23. When Ezra wept and prayed to confess the sin of the people, what did the people do? They wept bitterly; confessed their sin; separated themselves from their foreign family members.

#### Lesson 116

- 24. Who led the third group of Jews back to Judah? *Nehemiah*.
- 25. Why did Nehemiah want to return to Jerusalem? To rebuild the walls of the city.

- 26. Name one of Nehemiah's enemies who didn't want the walls rebuilt. (Ask several students.)
  Sanballat, Tobiah, Geshem.
- 27. Name two things Nehemiah did to protect the people while they worked on the wall. He armed the Jews with weapons. He set up a trumpet call to alert the people and bring them together if an attack occurred.

- 28. Nehemiah led the Jews as their king, governor, or minister? *Governor*.
- 29. What were some rich Jewish officials doing to their own people? Taking their food, land, houses, and money, forcing some to sell their children into slavery.
- 30. What did the nobles and officials do when Nehemiah told them they were sinning? They listened and returned what they had taken from the people.
- 31. Who did Nehemiah ask to read God's Word to the people? *Ezra*.

## Lesson 118

- 32. What is the last book in the Old Testament? *Malachi*.
- 33. Why did Malachi have to warn the priests? What were they doing wrong? They were offering imperfect animals (blind, lame, sick) to God as sacrifices.

- 34. In Malachi's prophecy, who would come to prepare the way for the Messiah: a messenger, a priest, or a king? A messenger.
- 35. Who was the messenger God sent to prepare the way for Jesus? *John the Baptist.*
- 36. The messenger in Malachi's prophecy would come in the spirit and power of which prophet: Elisha, Jeremiah, or Elijah? *Elijah*.

- 37. How many years passed between the Old Testament and the New Testament? 400 years.
- 38. Why are the years between the Old and New Testaments called the "Silent Years": God gave no new prophecies, God disappeared, or the Jews were quiet? God gave no new prophecies.
- 39. To whom did God give visions about some of the kings and empires to come? *Daniel*.
- 40. What language was spread by Alexander the Great and became the language of the New Testament? *Greek*.
- 41. What two main Jewish groups formed during the time of Greek rule? *Pharisees and Sadducees*.
- 42. What empire conquered the Jews and made travel easier by building roads and shipping ports? *Rome.*
