Review Questions

- 1. How many groups of Jews had already returned to Judah by the time of Nehemiah: one, two, or three? *Two*.
- 2. Who led the first group of Jews back to Judah with the permission of King Cyrus? Zerubbabel.
- 3. Who led the second group of Jews back to Judah with the permission of King Artaxerxes? Ezra.
- **4.** What bad news did Nehemiah hear about the Jews who were in Jerusalem? They were in trouble and shame because the walls were broken down and the gates were destroyed.
- 5. What did Nehemiah do when he heard the report about Jerusalem? He wept, fasted, and prayed, confessing his sins and the sins of the people.
- 6. What was Nehemiah's job for the king of Persia? Cupbearer; he tasted and served the king's drinks.
- 7. The king noticed that Nehemiah looked what? Sad.
- 8. What did the king give permission for Nehemiah to do? Return to Jerusalem to rebuild the walls.
- 9. What did Nehemiah do at night when he got to Jerusalem? He inspected the walls.
- 10. What did God put in Nehemiah's heart to do? Rebuild the walls.
- 11. What did the Jews say when Nehemiah shared his plan to rebuild the walls? They agreed to do it.
- **12.** Name one of the three men who opposed the building. (Allow several students to answer.) Sanballat, Tobiah, Geshem.
- 13. How did Nehemiah divide up the work on the walls? He assigned sections to different groups and families.
- 14. How did Sanballat and Tobiah try to discourage the Jews? They mocked them and their work on the wall.
- 15. When the wall was connected and built to half its height, what did the enemies of the Jews plan to do? Attack them and cause confusion (to stop the work).
- 16. What did Nehemiah and the Jews do to show their trust in God? They prayed.
- 17. What plan did Nehemiah use to make sure the work could continue, even with the threat of attack? He had half the people stay armed with weapons and half do the work. He had builders keep swords at their sides and others work with one hand while holding a sword in the other.
- 18. What did Nehemiah use to rally the people to one place in case of attack? *Trumpet*.
- 19. Thanks to God's protection and Nehemiah's plan, how long did it take the people to complete the walls: 52, 72, or 102 days? 52 days.
- 20. What is the reference of our new memory verse? Jeremiah 33:7-8.
 - Bonus: How many years after Ezra's return to Jerusalem was Nehemiah's return? 13 years later.
