- 1. How many C's do we use to remember the history of the world according to the Bible? Seven.
- 2. Which C's are recorded in the book of Genesis? Creation, Corruption, Catastrophe, and Confusion.
- 3. What is the last book in the Old Testament? Malachi.
- 4. Who did Malachi prophesy would come to prepare the way for the Lord? A messenger.
- 5. How many years passed between Malachi and the Gospels in the New Testament: 40, 400, or 4,000? 400 years.
- 6. What attribute of God means that he will always keep his promises? Faithful.
- 7. When did God first promise a Savior who would defeat Satan? In the garden of Eden after Adam and Eve sinned.
- 8. How was Jesus "bruised" or hurt when he came to earth? He died on the cross but rose again.
- 9. How did Jesus "bruise" or defeat Satan? He rose from the dead.
- 10. The message of the Old Testament is that the Messiah is coming or has come? Is coming.
- 11. God promised that whose descendants would be as numerous as the stars? Abraham's.
- **12.** How would God bless all the nations of the earth through Abraham? His descendant would be the Messiah, Jesus, who died for the sins of the world.
- **13.** How were the Passover lambs a picture of Jesus? The lambs were sacrificed and their blood spread on the doorposts to save the Israelites from the death of the firstborn (plague). Jesus was the perfect sacrifice who shed his blood on the cross to save us from eternal death (hell).
- 14. Why did God give the Ten Commandments? To show us our sin and need for a Savior.
- 15. Which king was given the promise that the Messiah would come from his descendants and establish an eternal kingdom? *David.*
- **16.** What is the message of the New Testament? The Messiah has come.
- 17. What title used for Jesus in the New Testament means he is the anointed one, the promised Messiah? *Christ*.
- **18.** How does Matthew 1:1 show God's fulfillment of his promises to Abraham and David? Jesus was descended from them just as God promised.
- 19. Whom did God use to speak to people in the Old Testament: kings, pastors, or prophets? Prophets.
- 20. Whom does God speak through today? His Son, Jesus.
- **21.** Where did Jesus go after making purification for our sins? At the right hand of the Father.
- 22. The time when God promises a new heaven and a new earth for all believers is called what? It's the seventh C. Consummation.
