

Play Dough Stones

Materials

- ☐ Play dough

Instructions

Give each student some play dough. Have them roll pieces into 12 balls and stack them up.

Option 1: Have students line up the dough balls then count together as they each make a stack.

Option 2: Time students to see who can stack the dough balls the fastest.

Suggested Discussion

Today, we stacked up play dough “stones” to help us remember our lesson.

- ? **Why did Joshua stack up stones? What were they for?** *To help them remember what God did for the Israelites at the Jordan River.*

God told Joshua to stack the stones as a memorial.

- ? **What is a memorial for?** *It helps us remember someone or something that happened.*

So when the Israelites’ children saw these stones, they could ask what they meant. Then the Israelites could tell them about the amazing things God did for them.
