Play Dough Stones

Materials

☐ Play dough

Instructions

Give each student some play dough. Have them roll pieces into 12 balls and stack them up.

Option 1: Have students line up the dough balls then count together as they each make a stack.

Option 2: Time students to see who can stack the dough balls the fastest.

Suggested Discussion

Today, we stacked up play dough "stones" to help us remember our lesson.

? Why did Joshua stack up stones? What were they for? To help them remember what God did for the Israelites at the Jordan River.

God told Joshua to stack the stones as a memorial.

? What is a memorial for? It helps us remember someone or something that happened.

So when the Israelites' children saw these stones, they could ask what they meant. Then the Israelites could tell them about the amazing things God did for them.
