Review Questions

- 1. Name the four Gospels in the New Testament. (Ask several students.) Matthew, Mark, Luke, John.
- 2. Who would send the Helper, the Holy Spirit, after Jesus was gone? The Father.
- 3. Name two things the Holy Spirit would do for the disciples. Teach them and help them remember what Jesus said.
- 4. Jesus called the Holy Spirit the Spirit of love, truth, or wisdom? Truth.
- 5. The Holy Spirit is one of the three persons of the what? *Trinity.*
- 6. The Trinity describes the three persons in one true what? *God.*
- 7. Who are the three persons of the Trinity? Father, Son, and Holy Spirit.
- 8. Which attribute of God describes how he knows everything: omnipotent, faithful, or omniscient? *Omniscient*.
- 9. Which attribute describes how God does everything perfectly without mistakes: wise, loving, or eternal? *Wise*.
- 10. How did John describe the testimony he wrote about Jesus? It was what? True.
- 11. When someone gives a testimony, what is he telling: something he read, something he saw, or his favorite story? Something he saw (or something that happened to him).
- **12.** Why did John write his account of Jesus' life? What did he want people to believe about Jesus? *That he is the Christ, the Son of God.*
- 13. What would believing in Christ give to people? Life in whose name? Life (eternal life) in Jesus' name.
- 14. Which disciple said that he and the other apostles did not follow myths when they wrote about Jesus: Peter, John, or James? *Peter.*
- 15. Peter and the other disciples saw the things they wrote about, so they were called what: news writers, eyeopeners, or eyewitnesses? *Eyewitnesses*.
- **16.** The apostles (disciples) were eyewitnesses of Jesus' what? Jesus' life (teachings and miracles), death, and resurrection.
- 17. Who persecuted believers then became a faithful follower after Jesus appeared to him: Paul, Mark, or Peter? *Paul/Saul*.
- 18. What did Peter call Paul's writings: Scriptures, scribblings, or books? Scriptures.
- 19. What are the handwritten copies of New Testament writings called: manuals, manuscripts, or transcripts? *Manuscripts*.
