# **Review Questions**

#### Lesson 81

- 1. What Philistine king did David and his men work for? *Achish*.
- 2. Because King Achish trusted David so much, what did David and his men almost have to do during the battle between the Philistines and the Israelites? Fight against their own people.
- 3. What happened to Ziklag while David and his men were away? Amalekites attacked the city and took all the possessions and all the people, including their wives and children.
- 4. What happened in the battle between the Philistines and the Israelites fighting under King Saul? The Israelites lost; Saul and three of his sons, including Jonathan, were killed.
- 5. After Saul's death, which tribe made David their king? *Judah*.
- 6. When David was finally made king of all Israel, what city did he choose for his capital? *Jerusalem*.

### Lesson 82

- 7. What special object did David want to bring to Jerusalem? The ark of the covenant.
- 8. What happened when Uzzah touched the ark to keep it from tipping on the cart? He was killed.
- 9. What was the correct way God told the people to carry the ark? The Levites were to carry the ark using long poles.
- 10. When the ark came safely to Jerusalem, what did David want to build for it? *A temple.*
- 11. What did God tell David about who would build the temple? David would not build it, but one of his sons would.
- 12. What special promise did God give David about one of his descendants? Jesus, the Messiah, would come from his family. Jesus would be King of kings forever.

#### Lesson 83

- 13. What was the name of the married woman David took for himself? *Bathsheba*.
- 14. What did David do to Uriah to cover up his sin? Had Uriah killed.
- 15. What parable did Nathan tell David to get him to recognize his terrible sin? A rich man with many flocks took and killed a poor man's pet lamb.
- 16. How did David respond when Nathan said that David was the rich man in the story? He confessed his sin and asked God for forgiveness; he repented.

#### Lesson 84

- 17. Which of David's sons killed one of his brothers and tried to take David's throne? *Absalom*.
- **18.** What did Absalom look like? He was handsome with long hair.
- 19. Where did the battle between Absalom and David's men take place? A forest.
- 20. What happened to Absalom in the battle against David's men? He got caught in a tree and was killed by David's commander Joab and his men.
- 21. How did David and Absalom respond differently when they sinned? David repented and Absalom didn't.

#### Lesson 85

- **22.** What kind of book is the book of Psalms? *Poetry.*
- 23. Which kind of psalm is a cry to God for help or asks God why bad things have happened? *Psalm of lament.*
- 24. Which kind of psalm is good for worshipping God through music, prayer, and song? *Psalm of praise*.

- 25. Which kind of psalm helps us remember to be grateful for the things God has done for us? *Psalm of thanksgiving.*
- **26.** Name a person who wrote a psalm. (Ask several students.) David, Solomon, Heman, Ethan, Asaph, Sons of Korah, Moses.

# Lesson 86

- 27. Which of David's sons was chosen to become king after David? *Solomon*.
- 28. When Solomon became king, what did he ask God for? Wisdom; understanding mind to rule the people well.
- 29. God was pleased with Solomon's request and gave him wisdom. What other blessings did God also give? *Riches and honor.*
- 30. How did Solomon deal wisely between the two women who were fighting over a baby? He figured out who the real mother was by seeing who chose to protect the baby when he threatened to cut him in half.
- **31.** Where can we get true wisdom? Ask God for it. God's Word.

# Lesson 87

- 32. Who gave Solomon instructions for building the temple and collected some of the materials they needed? *His father, David.*
- 33. How was the temple different from the tabernacle? The temple was a permanent (and beautiful) building in Jerusalem not a tent/structure that could be moved.
- 34. What piece of furniture that represents God's presence was put in the Most Holy Place in the temple? Ark of the covenant; ark of God.
- 35. How did God show he was pleased with the temple? His glory came in a cloud and filled the temple.
- 36. Name one of the furnishings in the temple.

  (Allow several students to answer.) Ark of the covenant, altar of incense, golden lampstands, tables for showbread, altar, and bronze sea (for washing).

## Lesson 88

- 37. Who wrote many proverbs to teach his son and the people? King Solomon.
- **38.** What is the purpose of a biblical proverb? To help us understand and use godly wisdom every day.
- **39.** What is the first step to gaining wisdom? The fear of the Lord—understanding who he is and respecting him.
- **40.** What kind of advice can we learn from Proverbs? Choosing friends, listening to our parents, controlling our words, being humble, and working hard.
- 41. Proverbs tells us to search for wisdom as we would search for what? *Hidden treasure.*
- 42. Will following the advice in Proverbs and living wisely save us from our sins? No, we are only saved by faith in Jesus when we repent and trust in him.

- **43.** What commands God gave for kings did Solomon disobey? He collected horses, gold, and silver. He married many foreign women.
- **44.** What sin did Solomon's foreign wives lead him into? *Worshipping false gods; idolatry.*
- **45.** What was God's punishment for Solomon's sin? He would take the kingdom away from his son and give it to his servant.
- 46. What was the name of Solomon's son who became king of the southern kingdom?

  Rehohoam.
- 47. What was the name of Solomon's servant who became king of the northern kingdom? *Jeroboam*.
- 48. What was the southern kingdom called? Judah.
- 49. What was the northern kingdom called? Israel.
- 50. What lessons can we learn from Solomon's mistakes? We can all be led astray by things in the world. Disobedience brings consequences/punishment. Our sins can affect others.
