Instructions

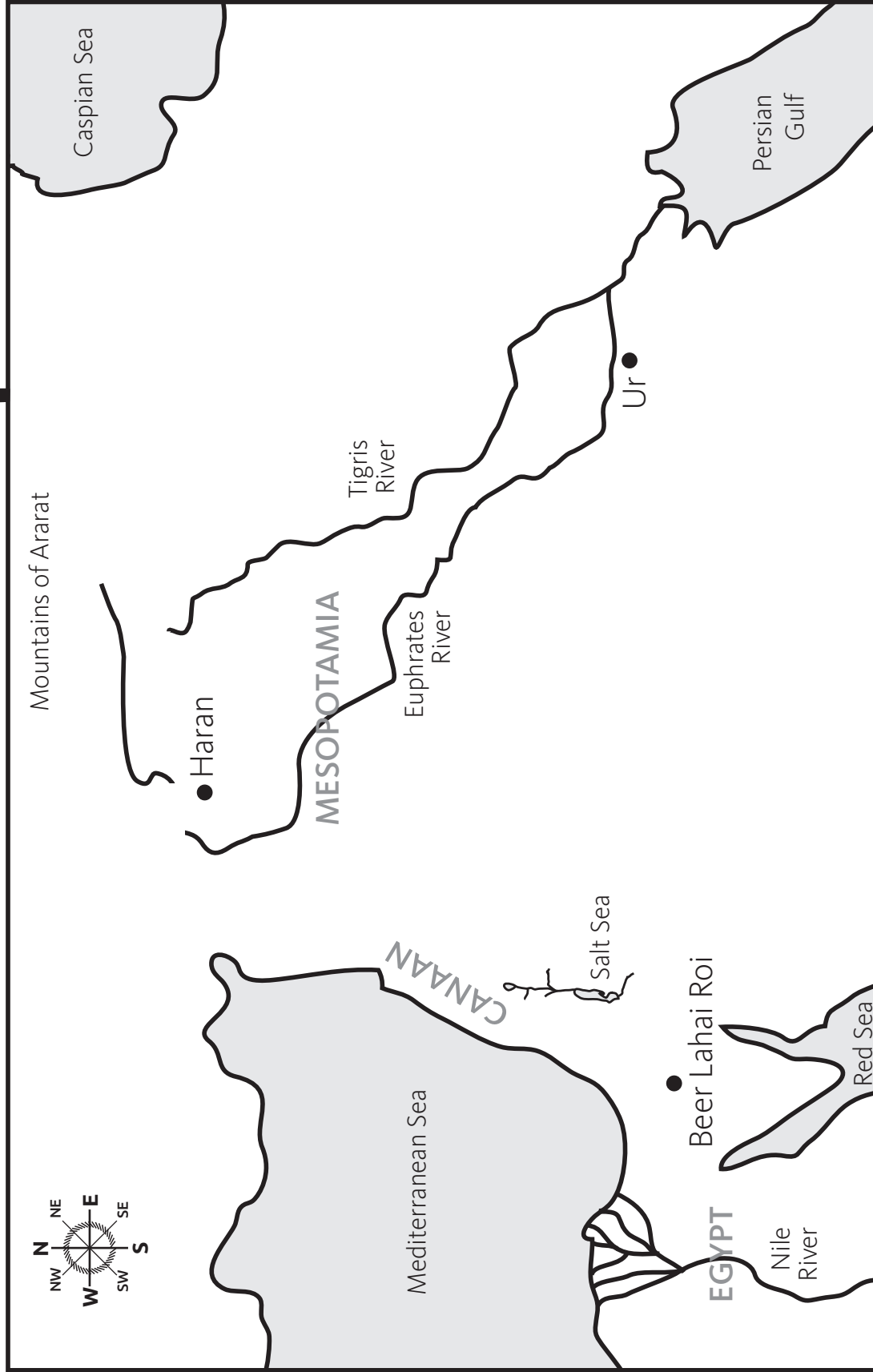
Print one copy of the Find It On the Map worksheet for each student.

Students will follow the directions below the map to trace the events and find the places in the lesson. You may read the directions and complete the steps as a class or let students work independently or in pairs.

Suggested Discussion

Abraham's servant had to cover a lot of ground in our lesson today! Travel was a lot more challenging back in Abraham's day. They rode camels or other animals and had to pack enough food and water for the trip. The 500-mile journey would have been hot and uncomfortable, even dangerous! But God gave the servant success and provided Rebekah as a bride for Isaac.

Find It On the Map



- Find and circle Ur on the map. It is northwest of the Persian Gulf.
- Cross out the word Ur because Abraham left Ur.
- Follow the Euphrates River up until you find the city of Haran.
- Draw a line from Ur to Haran because Abraham traveled there with his father.
- Cross out Haran because God called Abraham out of Haran.
- Find Canaan along the Mediterranean Sea. It is southwest of Haran.
- Draw a line from Haran to Canaan.
- Draw a few tents in the land of Canaan because Abraham and Isaac lived there in tents.
- Draw a dotted line between the tents in Canaan and Haran to represent the path Abraham's servant took to Haran.
- Draw a jug of water at Haran to represent Rebekah watering the servant's camels.
- Draw a man and woman by the tents in Canaan to represent Isaac and Rebekah finally married.
