## **Review Questions**

- 1. Why did David leave Israel for the land of the Philistines? Saul kept hunting him and trying to kill him.
- 2. What Philistine king of Gath did David serve for over a year? *Achish*.
- 3. What city did Achish give David and his men to live in? *Ziklag*.
- 4. Why did Achish think David would remain loyal to him? What did David tell him he and his men were doing? Achish thought David was raiding and stealing from people in Israel.
- 5. Who were David and his men actually raiding even though they told Achish they were attacking Israelites? Enemies of the Israelites.
- 6. Why did David and his men go with the Philistine army to attack the Israelites? Because they were servants of Achish, and he was a Philistine king.
- 7. How did God spare David and his men from having to fight their own people? The Philistine commanders sent them away and refused to let them fight.
- 8. What were the Philistines afraid David and his men would do during the battle? Turn against them and fight for the Israelites.
- 9. What happened to Ziklag, David's city, while he and his men were away with Achish?

  Amalekites raided the city, stole everything, captured the people, and burned it.
- 10. How did David and his men feel when they found Ziklag destroyed and their families gone? Sad, distressed, angry.
- 11. David's men were so upset their wives and children were taken that they talked about doing what to David? Stoning him.

- 12. Where did David turn for help and strength when his family was gone and his city destroyed? *God*.
- 13. What happened when David and his men pursued the Amalekites? They caught up to them, destroyed most of them, and recovered their families and everything that was taken.
- 14. What happened in the battle between the Philistines and the Israelites fighting under King Saul? The Israelites were defeated; Saul and his three sons were killed.
- 15. After Saul's death, David became king of which Israelite tribe? *Judah*.
- 16. What was the name of the commander of Saul's army? *Abner.*
- 17. Which remaining son of Saul did Abner make king of Israel? *Ish-bosheth*.
- **18. What happened to Ish-bosheth?** He was murdered by two of his own captains.
- 19. How long was David king of Judah before all of Israel came to make him king? Over 7 years.
- 20. What city did David conquer and make his new capital? *Jerusalem*.
- 21. Name one thing that made Jerusalem a good choice for a capital city. (Allow several students to answer.) It was a fortress protected by three deep valleys and walls. It had a source of fresh water. It was located along trade routes.
- 22. What good qualities did David show by waiting for God's timing? *Patience, faith.*

Bonus: Why did David's commander Joab kill Abner? Abner had killed Joab's younger brother in a battle, so Joab wanted revenge.

Bonus: What was the name of David's capital city when he was king of Judah? *Hebron*.
