



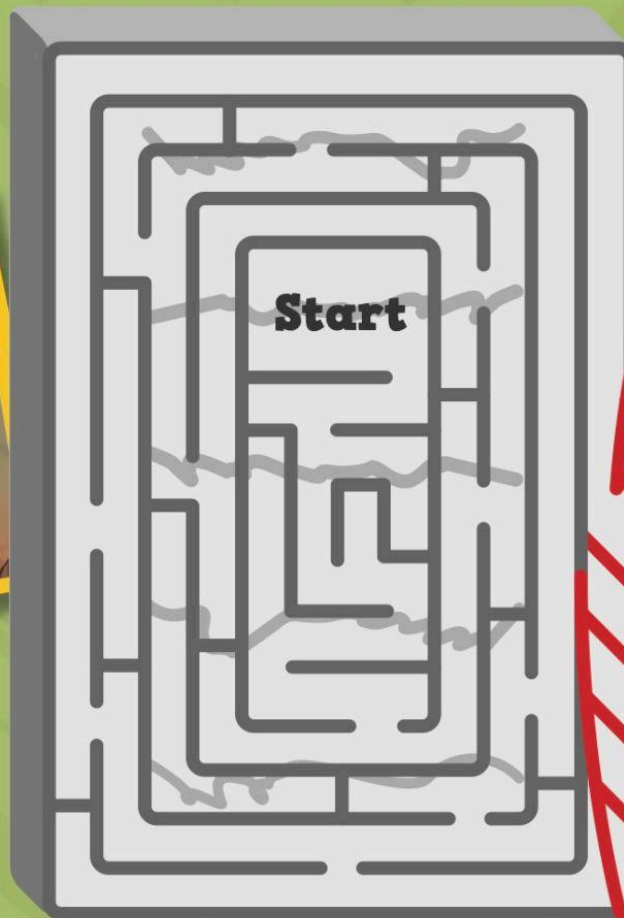
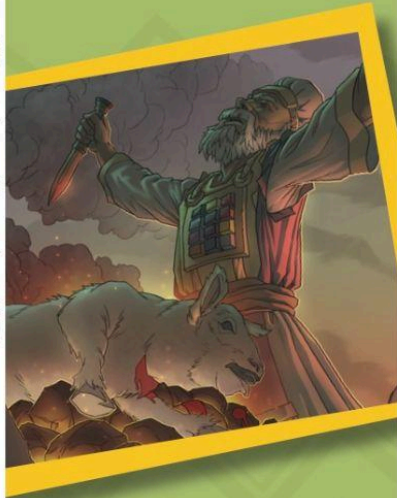

What You Heard *In the Word*

- Under the old covenant, the high priests sacrificed animals again and again to cover their sins and the sins of the people.
- Under the new covenant, Jesus Christ, the perfect high priest, died once to offer forgiveness of sins forever to those who repent and trust in him.

OutWord *For Family Discussion*

Suppose your friend tells you that she believes she will get to heaven because she tries to keep the Ten Commandments. **What could you say?**

A lot of people think that they can be good enough to get to heaven, but that idea isn't in the Bible. The Bible tells us that all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God. That means no one can be good enough to get to heaven. It's impossible for anyone to keep the Ten Commandments. Even one sin is enough to separate us from God forever! But God made a way for us to get to heaven. It's through Jesus. God sent Jesus to earth to take the punishment we deserve. The Bible says our sins can be taken away forever if we believe in Jesus, turning from our sins and receiving his free gift of salvation. That's the only thing we can do to please God! Then God will make us his children, and we can get to know him through his Word, the Bible, and look forward to being with him forever in heaven one day.
