Making a Difference

1. (1Cor. 4:2) What one requirement does God make of Christians?
 - *How does our faithfulness to Christ help our witness as a Christian?*
 - *How does our unfaithfulness hurt the cause of Christ?*
2. What are some practical ways you can model faithfulness to your children and others?
3. What were three ways the apostles exhibited their faithfulness, and how can they apply to us, as well? (*Hint: they are the sub-points under Main Point #3 of the lesson that will be taught*)
4. Our world is becoming less tolerant to Christianity, and our freedom to speak God's truths could become limited. What does (Acts 5:29) tell us we are to do when we are told to stop sharing the Gospel?
5. (1Peter 4:12-13) speaks of rejoicing as partakers of Christ's sufferings. How is it possible for someone to suffer and rejoice at the same time?
6. What is one area you would say you struggle most with faithfulness?
7. How did this lesson speak to you and what action step will it lead you to take? (*"Because of what I learned, I will..."*)
8. Share one thing God spoke to you about during your daily devotional time this past week.
