Journeys of Faith

1. Compare (Deut. 34:10 & Ex. 33:11). Describe the relationship between God and Moses.
 - *What qualities of Moses' relationship with God should we seek to emulate in our relationship with the Lord?*
2. (Deut. 9:9) Moses communed with God for 40 days and nights without interruption. What is an area of your walk with the Lord that you feel could use improvement?
 - *What are some steps you could take this week to make that improvement?*
3. (Heb. 1:1-2) In the Bible days, God spoke directly to the prophets like He spoke face to face with Moses. How does the Bible say God speaks to us "in these last days?"
 - *Since God speaks to us, today, through His Word, what does that teach us about the importance we should place on reading and studying God's Word?*
4. The Children of Israel had become idolatrous in their worship. An idol is something that takes God's place in your heart. What are some things people have turned into idols, today?
5. (1Cor. 10:21-22) What does it mean to be a partaker of the devil's table? How does that provoke the Lord when we do so?
6. How did this lesson speak to you and what action step will it lead you to take? (*"Because of what I learned, I will..."*)
7. Share one thing God spoke to you about during your daily devotional time this past week.
