- 1. (1Kings 17:3-5) How did God sending Elijah to the brook require Elijah to trust in God?
- 2. (1Kings 17:6) How did the ravens feeding Elijah demonstrate God's provision?
- 3. What lessons can we learn from Elijah's obedience to go where God instructed him, even when it was uncomfortable or risky?
- 4. (1Kings 17:7) When God allowed the brook to dry up, how did that challenge Elijah's faith?
- 5. (1Kings 17:8-9) When God sent Elijah to a widow who had so little to provide for his needs, what lesson did that teach Elijah about God's ability to provide?
 - What can this example teach us about trusting in God when we find ourselves in difficult circumstances?
- 6. How did Elijah have to show trust in God in his circumstance?
 - How did the widow have to trust God in her circumstances?
- 7. How did this lesson speak to you and what action step will it lead you to take? ("Because of what I learned, I will...")
- 8. Share one thing God spoke to you about during your daily devotional time this past week.

GROUP PRAYER TIME (Take any prayer requests)

- Pray for the prayer requests given.
- Whatever the Lord spoke to you about in this lesson, turn that into a prayer back to God. Is there something you need to *correct*, *confess*, or *continue* doing...tell Him about it.
- While one person is praying aloud, everyone else should focus on what is being prayed and should agree with them in prayer, until it is your turn to pray.
