2. According to (Ps. 133:1) and (Eph. 4:3), what is a vital ingredient for teamwork to happen?
 - *How can disunity in a church hurt its effectiveness and testimony?*
3. (Matt. 5:23-24) When problems arise between believers, what does the Bible instruct us to do before bringing our gift to the altar?
 - *When church members are at odds and refuse to be reconciled, in what ways can that hurt the church body?*
4. What were the positive results of teamwork given in our lesson? (*Hint: they are the sub-points under Main Point #3 of the lesson that will be taught.*)
 - *How would each of these benefit the church, today?*
5. What are some practical ways every church member can be a team player?
6. How did this lesson speak to you and what action step will it lead you to take? (*"Because of what I learned, I will..."*)
7. Share one thing God spoke to you about during your daily devotional time this past week.
