  - How does this truth run contrary to what our culture says?
- 3. If we truly only lived our lives for God's pleasure, how might that change our priorities?
  - What would be some top priorities for a person who is living for God's glory?
  - What does it say to unbelievers when they see that God is not first place in our lives?
- 4. Man wants to blame God for all of the death and evil in the world, but according to (Rom. 5:12) who is really responsible?
- 5. While having life on this earth is a blessing, what does (1John 2:25) say God has promised us that is far better?
- 6. (John 14:6) How do we know that all religions to not lead to God?
- 7. When someone says believing Jesus is the only way to Heaven is being narrowminded, how might we use (Matt. 7:14) to answer this?
- 8. Which daily devotional spoke to you the most, and why?
