- 3. Jesus honored the Father in the midst of unbelievers. What are some practical ways we can live out our faith among those who do not believe?
- 4. (John 8:50) Jesus trusted God as the Judge. How can this perspective help us deal with personal struggles and injustices?
- 5. (John 12:49) Jesus glorified the Father by speaking His words. How can we ensure that our words reflect God's truth in our conversations?
- 6. During the earthly ministry of Jesus, He was not always well received. But He did not let rejection stop Him from doing his father's work. What lesson can we learn from His example when we face rejection from the world?
- 7. Jesus is not meant to be one of many gods in our lives. What are some things that can easily take first place in our hearts instead of Jesus?
- 8. How did this lesson speak to you and what action step will it lead you to take? ("Because of what I learned, I will...")
- 9. Share one thing God spoke to you about during your daily devotional time this past week.
