2. As believers, we should make God our highest priority in life. This includes our time. What are some different ways we can make God a priority in how we spend our time? Discuss.
3. (Eph. 5:15) says we are to walk “not as fools, but as wise”. What are some foolish ways you see people living, that a believer would be “wise” to avoid? Discuss.
4. According to (Eph. 5:16) part of walking wisely mean doing what?
 - *What does it mean to redeem the time?*
 - *What are some example of ways we do not redeem our time?*
5. What area(s) do you find you most struggle with in the area of managing your time wisely?
 - *If time management isn’t a struggle for you, share ways you have learned to be successful at it, that might encourage others in this area.*
6. (Prov. 1:5) If a person is wise, how will they respond to “wise counsels”?
7. What daily devotional spoke to you the most, and why?
