

Lesson 13: Journey to the Empty Tomb

Luke 24:1-8

Journeys of Faith

1. (Luke 24:2-5) Jesus had promised He would rise again, but sometimes in a trial, fear can hinder us from remembering God's promises to us. When you face seasons of fear or uncertainty, what promises of God do you tend to forget?
2. (Luke 24:8) Finally, Mary and those with her remembered His words! Why is it important that we hear and remember God's Word?
3. (Luke 24:36-39) If we can learn anything from the Resurrection, it is that Jesus will always be with us! Why should that fact be a source of encouragement to us when in a trial?
4. When God forgives, He receives us back into fellowship with Himself. Read (Ps. 103:2-4) and list four actions performed by God, proving His complete forgiveness.
 - *If Jesus can forgive those who crucified Him, what should that teach us about the importance of forgiving those who mistreat us?*
 - *What are some hindrances to us forgiving others?*
5. (John 11:25) What is the ultimate transformation that can take place in our lives because of the death and resurrection of Jesus?
6. How did this lesson speak to you and what action step will it lead you to take? (*"Because of what I learned, I will..."*)
7. Share one thing God spoke to you about during your daily devotional time this past week.
