Acts 3:1-10

Making A Difference

1. (Acts 3:2a) This man was lame. He needed physical help. What are some practical ways we can meet a person's physical needs as a way to eventually reach them with the Gospel?
2. (Acts 3:2b) How long had this man been lame? How do you think the hope of healing may have affected him?
 - *How might the hope of the Gospel message affect those around us who are still living in the hopelessness of their sin?*
 - *How should that fact motivate us in our witnessing?*
3. (Acts 3:3-4) What were Peter and John doing when they encountered this lame man?
 - *They did not go seeking this man, but responded to his need as they were going about their day. What should that teach us about having an awareness of the needs of others as we go about our day?*
4. What are some ways we can be more aware of other's needs that we may come into contact with on a daily basis?
5. According to (2Cor. 5:17), what does a person become when he accepts Christ as his Saviour?
 - *What are some evidences of a person who has become a new creature in Christ?*
6. How did this lesson speak to you and what action step will it lead you to take? (*"Because of what I learned, I will..."*)
7. Share one thing God spoke to you about during your daily devotional time this past week.
