

## Lesson 3: The Spirit-Filled Life

Acts 4:29-31

Making A Difference

1. (Acts 4:29-30) What stands out to you about what the believers prayed for and what they did *not* pray for?
  - *Why do you think they asked for “boldness” rather than deliverance from persecution?*
  - *What fears or pressures today might keep believers from speaking the word of God with boldness?*
2. (Acts 4:31) says they were all “filled with the Holy Ghost.” What does being “filled with the Holy Ghost” look like in this passage, and how is it demonstrated?
3. (Eph. 5:18) What does this verse mean, that we are not to be drunk with wine, but be filled with the Spirit?
4. How can a Spirit-filled Christian make a difference in a church, a workplace, or a community?
5. According to Psalm 66:18, what prevents the Lord from hearing our prayers?
6. Once we are filled with the Spirit, does that mean we are automatically filled with the Spirit the entire day? If not, what are some ways we can remain sensitive to the Holy Spirit throughout our day?
7. How did this lesson speak to you and what action step will it lead you to take? (*“Because of what I learned, I will...”*)
8. Share one thing God spoke to you about during your daily devotional time this past week.
