

## Lesson 4: The Journey to Egypt

Gen. 37:1-10

Journeys of Faith

1. (Gen. 37:6-8) Joseph had been given a revelation from God and had the faith to share it with his brothers. What lesson can this teach us about sharing our faith with others?
2. (1Cor. 4:2) What is one thing God requires of His stewards?
  - *Joseph remained faithful despite his circumstances. What lesson can we learn from his example despite our bad circumstances?*
3. (2Tim. 3:12) What does the Bible say we can expect if we live a godly life?
  - *Why is it important that we endure persecution with a right attitude, as Joseph did?*
4. (1Pet. 5:10) What does the Bible say are the benefits we will receive if we suffer for God faithfully?
5. How could a promotion (to second-in-command over Egypt) have tempted Joseph to waver in his faithfulness to the Lord?
  - *How can you tell whether something is a blessing from God or a temptation from Satan?*
6. (Phil. 1:6) What promise are we given that should comfort us?
7. How did this lesson speak to you and what action step will it lead you to take? (*"Because of what I learned, I will..."*)
8. Share one thing God spoke to you about during your daily devotional time this past week.
