Luke 6:39-49 Consider Christ

- 1. (Luke 6:39) Why is it important that the leaders we follow are following the Lord?
- 2. (Luke 6:43-44) If a good tree does not produce corrupt fruit, and "every tree is known by his own fruit," what should we expect to see in the life of a person who is yielded to Jesus as Lord?
- 3. (Luke 6:45) What do the words that come out of our mouth reveal about us?
- 4. (Luke 6:46) What is one evidence that someone has not truly surrendered to Jesus as their Lord?
  - If others know we profess to be a Christian, yet we are living in disobedience to God's Word, what does that say about us?
- 5. (Luke 6:49) What does Jesus liken a person to who hear His Word but doesn't obey it? Explain.
- 6. What is the biggest reason we refuse the lordship of Christ?
- 7. What are our outward actions a true reflection of?
- 8. What would it look like, practically, to live out this truth, or how would your life look different if Jesus was in complete control of your life?
- 9. Share one thing God spoke to you about during your daily devotional time this past week.
