2. (1John 1:9) What two things does God promise to do when we confess our sin?
3. Should we expect God to remove the consequences of our sin, even after repenting? Why not?
 - *How should the knowledge that we may still suffer consequences for our sin affect us in the future when we are tempted?*
4. (Heb. 12:5) How are we to respond to God's chastening in our lives?
5. (Heb. 12:6) What two things do we learn from God's chastening?
6. (Rev. 3:19) How does God want us to respond to His loving rebuke and chastening?
 - *What does it mean to be "zealous" to repent?*
7. How did this lesson speak to you and what action step will it lead you to take? *("Because of what I learned, I will...")*
8. Share one thing God spoke to you about during your daily devotional time this past week.
