- 1. What are three evidences of genuine repentance we saw from David's life in this lesson? (Hint: they are the subpoints under Main Point #2) Discuss.
- 2. (1John 1:9) What two things does God promise to do when we confess our sin?
- 3. Should we expect God to remove the consequences of our sin, even after repenting? Why not?
  - How should the knowledge that we may still suffer consequen-ces for our sin affect us in the future when we are tempted?
- 4. (Heb. 12:5) How are we to respond to God's chastening in our lives?
- 5. (Heb. 12:6) What two things do we learn from God's chastening?
- 6. (Rev. 3:19) How does God want us to respond to His loving rebuke and chastening?
  - What does it mean to be "zealous" to repent?
- 7. How did this lesson speak to you and what action step will it lead you to take? ("Because of what I learned, I will...")
- 8. Share one thing God spoke to you about during your daily devotional time this past week.

- Pray for the prayer requests given.
