Consider Christ

1. (Heb. 12:2) What does it imply that Jesus is the “author” of our faith?” What does it imply that Jesus is the “finisher” of our faith?”
2. (Matt. 4:1-4) What did Jesus do when Satan tempted Him?
 - *What should that teach us about how to respond when the devil tries to tempt us?*
3. (James 1:2-4) Why does God allow us to go through trials and temptations?
4. (Gal. 5:16) What should we do in order to insure we do not “fulfill the lust of the flesh”?
 - *What does it mean to “Walk in the Spirit”?*
5. (John 17:4) How does Jesus' passion to glorify the Father inspire us to live for God's glory?
 - *What are some practical ways we can glorify God in our life?*
 - *Jesus' main purpose was to glorify the Father and redeem the lost. How should that influence our priorities as Christians?*
6. (1Pet. 1:2) What role does God's foreknowledge play in helping us trust His purposes, even when they are difficult to understand?
7. How did this lesson speak to you and what action step will it lead you to take? (*“Because of what I learned, I will...”*)
8. Share one thing God spoke to you about during your daily devotional time this past week.
