Luke 7:36-50 Consider Christ

- 1. (Luke 7:36-37) What obstacles might this woman have faced in coming to Jesus? What does this say about her faith?
- 2. (Luke 7:38-39) How does this woman's humility compare to the Pharisee's attitude? What does that teach us about the kind of heart God desires?
- 3. (Luke 7:39, Luke 15:1-2) Why do you think Jesus was often criticized by the religious leaders for showing grace to sinners?
 - How can we strike a proper balance between loving sinners where they are but not condoning their sin?
- 4. What practical steps can we take to ensure that we see people the way Jesus sees them, rather than the way the Pharisee saw this woman?
- 5. (Luke 7:47) Why do those who recognize the depth of their forgiveness tend to love God more deeply?
- 6. Why is acknowledging our own sinfulness essential before we can truly appreciate Christ's forgiveness?
- 7. How did this lesson speak to you and what action step will it lead you to take? ("Because of what I learned, I will...")
- 8. Share one thing God spoke to you about during your daily devotional time this past week.

GROUP PRAYER TIME (Take any prayer requests)

- Pray for the prayer requests given.
- Whatever the Lord spoke to you about in this lesson, turn that into a prayer back to God. Is there something you need to *correct*, *confess*, or *continue* doing...tell Him about it.
- While one person is praying aloud, everyone else should focus on what is being prayed and should agree with them in prayer, until it is your turn to pray.
