Acts 2:42-47

Making A Difference

1. (Acts 2:42) It says those who were saved continued faithfully in the “**doctrine.**” What is doctrine?
 - *Why should Bible doctrine be important to a believer?*
 - *What does (2Tim. 4:3) say about sound doctrine in the last days?*
2. (Acts 2:42) also says they continued faithfully in the “**fellowship, and in breaking of bread.**” Why is it important that we take part in church fellowship?
 - *What does true Christian fellowship look like according to this passage? How is it different from casual social interaction?*
3. (Acts 2:42) also says they continued faithfully in “**prayers.**” What role does prayer play in maintaining unity and spiritual strength in the church?
4. (Acts 2:43) Miracles accompanied the apostles. How did signs and wonders in the early church affirm the gospel message?
5. (Acts 2:44) says the believers were “together” and had “all things common.” What does this teach us about Christian community and sacrificial love?
6. How did this lesson speak to you and what action step will it lead you to take? (*“Because of what I learned, I will...”*)
7. Share one thing God spoke to you about during your daily devotional time this past week.
