

Lesson 6: The Journey to the Promised Land

Joshua 1:1-9

Journeys of Faith

1. (Josh. 1:2) What fears do you think Joshua faced when God called him to replace the great leader, Moses, to lead Israel?
2. (Josh. 1:5) What promise did God give Joshua to help him trust God's leading in his life?
3. (Heb. 13:5) How should God's promise to never leave **us** encourage us, like Joshua, to follow God when the circumstances seem overwhelming?
4. (Ex. 24:13) Joshua was Moses' minister. Not only was he a servant of the Lord, but He also served God's man. What are some ways we can minister to, and encourage, our pastor and other godly leaders in our lives?
5. (Mark 10:43-44) The measure of a man's greatness is not how many people serve him, but how many he serves. How does this truth run contrary to what our culture says?
6. (Ex. 24:18) Joshua spent 40 days waiting for Moses on Mt. Sinai. He could have gotten impatient, frustrated, or bored, but he chose to faithfully and patiently wait on Moses. What should Joshua's example teach us about the importance of waiting on the Lord?
7. (Josh. 1:8) What does God say the key to success is?
8. How did this lesson speak to you and what action step will it lead you to take? (*"Because of what I learned, I will..."*)
9. Share one thing God spoke to you about during your daily devotional time this past week.
