

Lesson 12: The Journey to the Cross

John 17

Journeys of Faith

1. (John 17:1) When Jesus said, “Father, the hour is come...” He was acknowledging that God’s plan is according to God’s timing. How should God’s timing in our lives be a source of encouragement to us?
2. (John 17:4) During the toughest trial of Christ’s earthly life, He still glorified the Father. What does this teach us about what our focus should be during our trials?
 - *Compare with (1Cor. 6:20). What are some specific ways in which we can glorify God during a trial?*
3. (John 17:6) If Jesus “manifested” the Father’s name unto men, what does that teach us about the importance of sharing the name of Jesus with others?
4. (John 18:5) Judas betrayed Jesus, even though he pretended to be a true disciple. What are some ways that Christians, today, might be guilty of also betraying Christ, to some degree?
5. (John 15:13) Jesus proved His love for us by laying down His life for us. What are some ways we can show that we truly love Jesus?
6. How did this lesson speak to you and what action step will it lead you to take? (*“Because of what I learned, I will...”*)
7. Share one thing God spoke to you about during your daily devotional time this past week.
