### Important words that Luke uses in Luke 1:

- v2: by those who from the first were **eyewitnesses**...
- v3: have carefully investigated everything from the **beginning**...
- v3: an orderly account for **you**...
- v4: so that we may know the **certainty** of the things we've been taught
- v6: "Righteous" means to be in right relationship with God through faith
- v13: **"Do not be afraid"** is used 365 times in the Bible. One time for each day of a calendar year!

### How do I move from uncertainty towards certainty in my journey with Jesus?

- » We Ask
- » We Decide
- » We Embrace Grace
