WEEKLY CHECK-IN:

Last week we asked why Mary was chosen to be the mother of Jesus. How would you answer this question?

DISCUSSION:

- 1. What in this week's scripture was most interesting?
- 2. Why do you think the angel appeared to Joseph after he already knew Mary was pregnant? Why didn't the angel appear to Joseph to tell him Mary was pregnant?
- 3. What emotions do you think Joseph had before the angel appeared? Do you think his feelings changed after the angel appeared to him? If so, in what ways?
- 4. In the sermon, we discussed that Joseph <u>listened</u> because he was <u>humble</u>; therefore, Joseph was <u>obedient</u>, which resulted in Joseph being <u>faithful</u>. What are your thoughts about this progression? What part of the progression do you struggle with the most?
- 5. Immanuel means "God with us." Describe the significance of this phrase. How would you describe the meaning and importance of Immanuel to someone who doesn't have a relationship with Jesus?
- 6. What can we learn about God from this week's scripture?
- 7. What can we learn about people from this week's scripture?
