# STUDY QUESTIONS

## GETTING STARTED:

Share a time when something you thought was impossible actually happened. How did that change your perspective?

## A DEEPER DIVE:

- » What areas of your life are you giving attention to in hopes of gaining fulfillment, and how might those pursuits be keeping you from experiencing the transformation Jesus offers?
- » The beggar had to leave behind his worn-out cloak that defined his identity when he received healing. What 'cloak' or identity marker might Jesus be calling you to leave behind in order to step into new life?
- » Peter boldly proclaimed that salvation is found in no other name but Jesus. In a world with countless options for meaning and purpose, what makes the exclusive claim of Jesus' name both challenging and compelling?
- » Baptism is described as putting to death our sins and being raised to new life. If you have been baptized, how does remembering your baptism help you daily leave behind what holds you back and walk in resurrection power?
- » If you have not been baptized, what might be holding you back? Jesus offers you life through believing in what he has done. Baptism is an act of acknowledgement that it is through Jesus we receive forgiveness of sins and eternal life. We pledge of our lives to follow him.
- » If you would like to go all in for Jesus share that with someone in your group. You can take that step of faith today!

Identify one specific thing you need to "leave in the grave"—a habit, mindset, relationship pattern, or identity marker that keeps you stuck. Share it with one trusted person and ask them to pray for you and check in throughout the week.
