- 4. How would you describe your own life? Is your house/life right with God?
- 5. In what ways has our world distorted love? How would you describe love? For further discussion, read John 14:15-21.
- 6. What can we learn about God from this week's scripture?
- 7. What can we learn about people from this week's scripture?

In David's life, how did he respond to the love of God? How should we respond to the love of God?
