

Title: Compassion

Scripture: John 8:1-11

Date Preached: January 31, 2021

DISCUSSION STARTER:

When you were a child, were you the one telling on others or were people telling on you?

DISCUSSION:

Read the scripture text as a group. If you were unable to worship with us on Sunday, you can watch this week's sermon at <u>my.worthingtoncc.org/listen</u>.

- 1. In this passage, where was Jesus and what was he doing? Why is this significant to what was about to happen?
- 2. Why did the teachers of the law and the Pharisees bring this woman to Jesus? What were they hoping to do? (For further discussion, read Deuteronomy 22:22. Why didn't the teachers of the law and the Pharisees also bring the man involved?)
- 3. What was Jesus' immediate response? Why do you think he kept quiet? How did the Pharisees respond to Jesus' silence?
- 4. Do you enjoy sitting in silence or do you struggle with silence? Why is it important to be still in the presence of God?
- 5. How do you think the woman felt when Jesus spoke to her in verses 10-11? What is your response to God's kindness in your life?

How can you be still this week and silently reflect on your relationship with Jesus?
