

Title: Peter's Confession

Scripture: Matthew 16:13-20

## DISCUSSION STARTER:

How do you normally handle important conversations? Do you prefer to have it over the phone or in-person? If inperson, does the environment have a role to play when having an important conversation?

## DISCUSSION:

Read the scripture text as a group. If you were unable to worship with us on Sunday, you can watch this week's sermon at <u>my.worthingtoncc.org/listen</u>.

- 1. Describe the context of the scene in chapter 16. What are the Pharisees now asking of Jesus? Where does Jesus take the disciples and why does he change the scenery?
- 2. Why did Jesus ask the disciples the first question in verse 13? What do you think about the initial response of the disciples?
- 3. What is the significance of verse 15? What are the implications of this specific question?
- 4. How would you describe Peter's answer? What is the significance of Jesus being the Messiah? How would you describe Jesus' response to Peter?
- 5. What is your response to Jesus' words, "on this rock I will build my church, and the gates of Hades will not overcome it."?

## MY NEXT STEP:

Articulate an answer to the question Jesus asked of his disciples, "Who do you say I am?" Write down your answer and then think about what this answer means to your life and the way you live.
