DISCUSSION STARTER:

This month we have discussed the resurrection of Jesus and the events following his resurrection. Which encounter or event resonates with you most?

DISCUSSION:

- 1. What are the most common lies spread about Jesus today? Have you had any interactions with these falsehood stories?
- 2. Why do you think the chief priests devised a plan to deceive people about Jesus' resurrection instead of believing themselves?
- 3. What stands out to you in the Great Commission?
- 4. What is significant about the promise Jesus gives at the end of Matthew's gospel? Do you ever need to be reminded of this promise? How would you live differently always knowing that Jesus is with you?
- 5. If you were one of the disciples hearing Jesus tell you this on the mountain, how would you have felt? What would you have done next?
- 6. How does the Great Commission apply to us today?

MY NEXT STEP:

Reflecting on the last four weeks of our Risen study, what is God asking you to do next? Do you need to respond to the gospel and go all-in with Jesus? Do you need to "go" and take the gospel to someone who is yet to know Jesus?
