WEEKLY CHECK-IN:

- 1. What in this week's scripture was most interesting?
- 2. Describe Goliath. Why were the Israelites so afraid of him? What were the proposed stakes of the battle?
- 3. What about David's history prepared him for the battle against Goliath? When have you felt like God was using your past to prepare you for something in the future?
- 4. Why didn't David wear Saul's armor? Why do we sometimes try to be someone we are not instead of embracing our true selves?
- 5. How did David approach Goliath? How should we use David's approach to difficult situations in our life?
- 6. What can we learn about God from this week's scripture?
- 7. What can we learn about people from this week's scripture?
