- 4. How would you describe Absalom? Does he remind you of Saul, David, or neither?
- 5. David faces a lot of "unfortunate events" in his life. Does the character of David change in the events found in this week's chapters? Explain your answer.
- 6. What can we learn about God from this week's scripture?
- 7. What can we learn about people from this week's scripture?
