WEEKLY CHECK-IN:

- 1. What in this week's scripture was most interesting?
- 2. Why was it such a big deal for Israel to ask for a king? What did Israel want in a king?
- 3. How did Samuel respond to the elders? What was different in the way Samuel responded and the way the elders responded to the situation?
- 4. What stands out to you about Saul in chapter 9? Why do you think God chose Saul to be Israel's first king? What would be Saul's mission? (vs. 17)
- 5. Israel lacked trust that God would provide for them and asked for a king. Why is trust a hard thing for us to learn, especially when it comes to trusting God?
- 6. What can we learn about God from this week's scripture?
- 7. What can we learn about people from this week's scripture?

Where is God currently working in my life and where do I need to trust him in the process?
