- 4. Reflecting over the past few weeks of our study and thinking about the future events in Jesus' life, what role did Bethlehem play in Jesus' life? What about the role of Nazareth?
- 5. Reflecting on all of the events surrounding the birth of Jesus, which event resonates or impacts you the most?
- 6. What can we learn about God from this week's scripture?
- 7. What can we learn about people from this week's scripture?
