DISCUSSION STARTER:

As we enter into the summer, what are you hoping to accomplish during this season?

DISCUSSION:

Read the scripture text as a group. If you were unable to worship with us on Sunday, you can watch this week's sermon at <u>my.worthingtoncc.org/listen</u>.

- 1. How would you describe the Pharisees and the teachers of the law? Is there a common day example of this group?
- 2. Why are the Pharisees frustrated with the disciples? What were they hoping to accomplish by asking Jesus about the disciples' habits?
- 3. Why did Jesus rebuke the Pharisees? How were they being hypocritical? What does hypocrisy look like in Christianity today?
- 4. Jesus states that it is what comes out of the heart that makes a person pure. Why was this such a strong teaching to the Jews? What are the implications of this teaching to our walk with Jesus today?
- 5. How are our hearts connected to our relationship with Jesus? Read Proverbs 4:23. What does this verse tell us about the condition of our heart and the connection it has to our actions?

MY NEXT STEP:

Read Luke 6:45. Our words and actions come from the overflow of our heart. Reflecting on your own life, how would you gauge the matter of your heart?
