Who is Jesus?

Matthew 16:15-16, 21:1-11 | March 29, 2026

*As the time approached for him to be taken up to heaven,
Jesus resolutely set out for Jerusalem.*

— Luke 9:51

- » **Jesus doesn't accept neutrality** — We cannot stay neutral about who Jesus is; neutrality is actually a rejection.
- » **Jesus set His face toward Jerusalem** — Knowing what awaited Him, Jesus didn't hesitate because He had us in mind.
- » **Jesus is always at the center of our chaos** — He's not too far ahead or behind; He's right where we need Him.
- » **Jesus wept for those who missed Him** — Not because of the crowds, but because people were close to Him yet didn't truly know Him.

STUDY QUESTIONS

GETTING STARTED:

If you could ask Jesus one question face-to-face, what would it be and why?

A DEEPER DIVE:

- » How does your personal answer to the question 'Who is Jesus?' shape the way you live your daily life and make decisions?
- » Jesus fulfilled over 300 prophecies with astronomical odds against coincidence. How does understanding the prophetic accuracy of Jesus' life impact your faith and confidence in Scripture?
- » The sermon states that staying neutral about Jesus is actually a form of denying Him as Lord. Why do you think neutrality is not an option when it comes to responding to Jesus?
- » Peter made a personal confession that Jesus is the Messiah, the Son of the Living God. What barriers or fears might prevent someone from making that same personal declaration today?
- » The sermon illustrates how Johnny Mac's faithful life created a domino effect leading others to Christ. How might your personal relationship with Jesus impact those around you, both now and after your time on earth?
- » If Jesus were to ask you personally right now, 'But what about you? Who do you say that I am?', how would you answer, and does your life consistently reflect that answer?
