- 4. Why does it hurt when other people compare us to something or someone they think is better? What are some action steps we can take to guard against that hurt?
- 5. What areas of your life are you tempted to be jealous of? How can you guard against those feelings?
- 6. What can we learn about God from this week's scripture?
- 7. What can we learn about people from this week's scripture?
