

Consider 1st God's analysis - misplaced priorities

Haggai 1

- In the second year of King Darius, in the sixth month, on the first day of the month, the <u>word of the LORD came</u> by Haggai the prophet to Zerubbabel the son of Shealtiel, governor of Judah, and to Joshua the son of Jehozadak, the high priest, saying,
- Thus speaks the LORD of hosts, saying: 'This people says, The time has not come, the time that the LORD's house should be built.
- 3 Then the word of the LORD came by Haggai the prophet, saying,
- 4 <u>Is it time for you yourselves to dwell in your paneled houses</u>, and <u>this temple to</u> lie in ruins?

God explains the Hand behind the consequences

Haggai 1

- 5 Now therefore, thus says the LORD of hosts: "Consider your ways!
- 6 You have sown much, and bring in little; You eat, but do not have enough; You drink, but you are not filled with drink; You clothe yourselves, but no one is warm; And he who earns wages, <u>Earns</u> wages to put into a bag with holes.
- 7 Thus says the LORD of hosts: "Consider your ways!
- 9 You <u>looked for much</u>, but indeed it came to little; and when you brought it home, <u>I blew</u> it away.

 Why?" says the LORD of hosts. "<u>Because of My house that is in ruins, while every one of you runs to</u> his own house.
- 10 Therefore the heavens above you withhold the dew, and the earth withholds its fruit.
- 11 For <u>I called</u> for a drought on the land and the mountains, on the grain and the new wine and the oil, on whatever the ground brings forth, on men and livestock, and on all the labor of your hands."

Consider 3rd God prescribed cure - Make Me Priority

Haggai 1

8 Go up to the mountains and bring wood and build the temple, that <u>I may take pleasure</u> in it and <u>be glorified</u>," says the LORD.

Matthew 6:33

But seek ye first the kingdom of God, and his righteousness; and all these things shall be added unto you.

God's Presence when we make Him priority

Haggai 1

- 12 the high priest, with all the remnant of the people, <u>obeyed the voice of the LORD their God</u>, and the words of Haggai the prophet, as the LORD their God had sent him; and the people <u>feared the presence of the LORD</u>.
- 13 Then Haggai, the LORD's messenger, spoke the LORD's message to the people, saying, "I am with you, says the LORD."
- 14 So the LORD <u>stirred up the spirit</u>.... of all the remnant of the people; and <u>they</u> <u>came and worked on the house of the LORD of hosts, their God</u>
