#### **2 Timothy 2:5-6** NKJV

- 5 And also if anyone competes in athletics, he is not crowned unless he competes according to the rules.
- 6 The hardworking farmer must be first to partake of the crops.

### 3. Hold to the truth (2:15-19)

#### 2 Timothy 2 NKJV
