Hidden life

1 Kings 17:2-3

Then the word of the LORD came to him, saying,

"Get away from here and turn eastward, and hide by the Brook Cherith, which flows into the Jordan.

Provisions? ... on Me

1 Kings 17:4

And it will be that you shall drink from the brook, and I have commanded the ravens to feed you there."

Swift obedience

1 Kings 17:5

So he <u>went</u> and <u>did according to the word</u> of the LORD, for he went and stayed by the Brook Cherith, which flows into the Jordan.

God's consistence faithfulness

1 Kings 17:6

The ravens brought him bread and meat in the morning, and bread and meat in the evening; and he drank from the brook.

What up with dryness?

1 Kings 17:7

And it happened after a while that the brook <u>dried up</u>, because there had been no rain in the land.

Lessons and challenges from being hidden at the brook

Recognize and accept when God is calling you to Himself for special 1-on-1 time by the brook.

Remember the brook was never your source; God was and is.

Dried brooks produce new opportunities to mature and for service to the Lord.
