

Key Verse

Consolation

Luke 2:25 NKJV

And behold, there was a man in Jerusalem whose name was Simeon, and this man was just and devout, waiting for the Consolation of Israel, and the Holy Spirit was upon him.

- The return of hope, or comfort
- Assistance with loss and suffering
- Liberty, fellowship, divine Presence

Historical Setting

Luke 2:22-24 NKJV

- Now when the days of her purification according to the law of Moses were completed, they brought Him to Jerusalem to present Him to the Lord
- 23 (as it is written in the law of the Lord, "Every male who opens the womb shall be called holy to the Lord".),
- 24 and to offer a sacrifice according to what is said in the law of the Lord, "A pair of turtledoves or two young pigeons"

1. Seeking the will of God (righteousness) and having a (faithfully) walk before others positions us for blessings

Luke 2 NKJV

25 And behold, there was a man in Jerusalem whose name was Simeon, and this man was just and devout, waiting for the Consolation of Israel, and the Holy Spirit was upon him.

26 And it had been revealed to him by the Holy Spirit that he would not see death before he had seen the Lord's Christ.

2. Fellowshipping with the Holy Spirit positions us to be led by the Spirit.

Luke 2 NKJV

33 And Joseph and His mother marveled at those things which were spoken of Him.

34 Then Simeon blessed them, and said to Mary His mother, "Behold, this Child is destined for the fall and rising of many in Israel, and for a sign which will be spoken against

(yes, a sword will pierce through your own soul also), that the thoughts of many hearts may be revealed."

Isaiah 9:6-7

- For unto us a Child is born, Unto us a Son is given; And the government will be upon His shoulder. And His name will be called Wonderful, Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace.
- 7 Of the increase of His government and peace There will be no end, Upon the throne of David and over His kingdom, To order it and establish it with judgment and justice From that time forward, even forever. The zeal of the Lord of hosts will perform this.
