Anchors of Faith

Romans 5:1-4

- Therefore, having been justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ,
- 2. through whom also we have access by faith into this grace in which we stand, and rejoice in hope of the glory of God.
- 3. And not only that, but we also glory in tribulations, knowing that tribulation produces perseverance;
- 4. and perseverance, character; and character, hope.



Anchors of Faith

Romans 5:5-8

- 5. Now hope does not disappoint, because the love of God has been poured out in our hearts by the Holy Spirit who was given to us.
- 6. For when we were still without strength, in due time Christ died for the ungodly.
- 7. For scarcely for a righteous man will one die; yet perhaps for a good man someone would even dare to die.
- 8. But God demonstrates His own love toward us, in that while we were still sinners, Christ died for us.



<u>Realize</u> our present position

Romans 5:2b

• <u>Recognize</u> God's purposes

- <u>Recall</u> God's Amazing Grace

 - 8. But God demonstrates His own love toward us, in that while we were still sinners, Christ died for us.

Romans 5:6-8

<u>Recall</u> God's Amazing Grace

Romans 8: 31

- 31. What shall we then say to these things? If God be for us, who can be against us?
- 32. He that spared not his own Son, but delivered him up for us all, how shall he not with him also freely give us all things?
- 38. For I am persuaded that neither death nor life, nor angels nor principalities nor powers, nor things present nor things to come,
- 39. nor height nor depth, nor any other created thing, shall be able to separate us from the love of God which is in Christ Jesus our Lord..
